

Help from the Membership

Once again - membership data is under a re-assessment. We last carried out an update of membership details in 2006 - an exercise that highlighted various anomalies in our records as well as outdated and incorrect personal details. We send out the quarterly Journal and Newsletter to all members who have registered their personal and address information with us on joining, etc. However, many times we receive notification of members no longer residing at these addresses - members who have moved out of the GM area- and, unfortunately, members who have passed away.

(Most often after the event has happened !).

It is my intention to update our records once again and soon you will be receiving a similar request form highlighting the information I hold here - strictly confidential and observing the conditions of the Data Protection Act .

Since 2006 and the last official 'census' of membership details we have grown in numbers by approximately 25% - our membership total stands at 259.

One area I am keen to develop is making more use of modern technology and hence - the internet and email. I would also like to

develop a Manchester IA page on the social networks - such as 'facebook', etc. This practice is already in operation for such sites as the Ostomy C3 Life Organisation.

I am very aware that many members are not 'internet-savvy' and, of course, this will never preclude any information/news, etc ever reaching you.

Initially, I would like to create an accurate email address book of those members who have email addresses already. To do this I ask that all members with an email address send me an email -

And simply write in the 'Subject' line : "AddMember" without the quotes - and press 'send'

Some of your email addresses I may already have - this will simply confirm.

Finally - in these days of high production costs/ mail charges, printing, etc. What we save on administration costs we can 'plough' into worthwhile causes and events and charitable works.
